Hair	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Must be clean and neatly groomed ● Boys must be clean-shaven ● Natural-born hair colors are acceptable (i.e. full-colored, highlight, ombre, etc.) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● No hairstyle with distracting, extreme, vibrant, and/or bright hair colors (i.e. blue, green, orange, pink, purple, red, etc.) ● No distracting or extreme hairstyles (i.e. punk-rock cuts, mohawks, reverse mohawks, or spiked hair higher than one inch) ● No eyebrow clipping ● Sideburns shall not extend below the earlobe
Jewelry	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Only earrings, necklaces, bracelets, watches, and rings 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● No mouth grills ● No gauges, spacers, spikes, or tracers ● No eyebrow, nose, lip, or other facial piercings/jewelry allowed

General

ALL DRESS/GROOMING IS SUBJECT TO ADMINISTRATOR'S DISCRETION.

- Students shall wear appropriate undergarments. No pull-ups/diapers allowed.
- Students shall NOT wear sunglasses inside school building/during instructional day unless prescribed by a physician.
- Students shall NOT wear apparel displaying alcoholic or illegal substances, such as tobacco, the occult, religious, violence, death, and/or sexually related content, and any other distracting display.
- Students shall NOT wear any apparel suggesting gang affiliations.
- Exposed tattoos MUST be covered.
- Speciality attire may be worn on designated days as approved by administration.
