### **Description of Processes Used for Planning the Application:**

- Superintendent met with all campus and district level groups to get preliminary suggestions
- Survey released to all parents, students, staff and community members; survey input solicited
- District leadership reviewed stakeholder recommendations and develop district-level recommendations
- Recommendations shared with District ESSER Committees for feedback
- Revised recommendations were shared at a public hearing and with all other stakeholders
- District leadership meets to adjust and prioritize plan based on feed back
- Revised plan presented to the School Board for feedback and comments
- Plan continues to be revised as additional feedback and district needs become evident

- Attendance Support to help families get their children back to school
